I'll be teaching on the topics of evangelism and the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. While there I will also be ministering to approximately 15 local Assemblies of God Pastors.

Another trip is being planned for me to accompany my Pastor friends in July to visit several churches that they started a few years ago in Honduras.

Prayers and gifts are greatly appreciated for these upcoming trips. The Cuba trip will cost \$1750-\$2000 and the El Salvador trip, \$1500-\$1700.
